August 11th, 2018

This afternoon we depart the Kootenay's and head over to Kelowna for our overnight stay at the Best Western Plus. After we settle in we will be having a group Dinner here at the Hotel. Then off to bed as we have an early start tomorrow. (D)

August 12th, 2018

This morning we will be having a bagged breakfast on our way to the Airport with a private transfer. Our flight departs at 6:15am thru Calgary and then off to Halifax where we will be met with our private transfer over to our hotel the Cambridge Suites for the next 3 nights. We arrive at 5:48 local time. After we get settled we will have Dinner right here in the Hotel and then off to bed. (B, D)

August 13th, 2018

This morning after breakfast we will depart the hotel at 10:15am for a tour of the beautiful City of Halifax. We will then arrive at the Seaport Farmers Market where lunch is on your own and you can do a bit of shopping while we are here. Next we are off to Pier 21 for a guided

tour followed by some free time. Then we are heading back to the hotel to freshen up and then we are heading for the Grafton Street Dinner Theatre for Dinner and a Show. Back to the hotel and a good night's rest. (B, D)

August 14th, 2018

Today after breakfast we will be departing the hotel at 9:45am so we can do the Harbour Hopper tour on a frog! Then we are heading off to the Alexander Keith's Brewery for a tour and a bit of tasting. Then we will go back to the hotel where your afternoon is at your leisure. We will be departing the hotel at 5:30pm to head out for a Dinner Cruise and then back to our hotel for the evening. (B, D)

August 15th, 2018 Halifax NS to Moncton NB

This morning we will be departing our hotel and joining the rest of the group. Explore the Bay of Fundy and learn about the world's highest tides as we meander the colorful coastline to New Brunswick. We will explore the Joggins Fossil Cliffs, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where you will see magnificently exposed layers of rock revealing the world's most complete fossil record of life in the coal age of 300 million years ago. After crossing into New Brunswick, an unforgettable culinary experience awaits as you enjoy a scrumptious Lobster Dinner on a Lobster boat. Then we continue on to Moncton and check into our downtown hotel the Crowne Plaza for the night. (CB, L, D)

August 16th, 2018 Moncton NB to Saint John NB

Experience a true natural wonder this morning at the Hopewell Rocks on the coast of the Bay of Fundy. Marvel at these massive flower-pot shaped formations sculpted by the highest tides on the planet. Travel through Fundy National Park on to Canada's first incorporated city, Saint John, on the Southern New Brunswick coast. Enjoy a city tour, including Reversing Falls where twice daily the Bay of Fundy tides force the Saint John River to reverse its flow. Tonight we check into the Hilton Saint John for a two night stay. (B, L)

August 17th, 2018 St. Andrews by-the-Sea

Enjoy a trip to picturesque St. Andrews by-the-Sea where the quaint charm of this coastal town is sure to captivate. After a Whale Watching Boat Tour (weather permitting), the afternoon is yours to experience the friendly people, beautiful architecture, and rich marine life of this seaside gem at your own pace. August 18th, 2018 Saint John, NB to Annapolis Valley NS

Ferry back to Nova Scotia this morning and arrive in Digby, the scallop capital of the world, where the fresh sea air and passionate Acadian culture combine to form an enchanting and historically rich town. Today we check into the Digby Pines Golf Resort & Spa overlooking the Annapolis Basin on the Bay of Fundy. (B, D)

August 19th, 2018 Annapolis Valley NS to Halifax NS

Travel the lush Annapolis Valley where the French Acadians of Grand Pre made their first settlement in the early 1600's. Learn about this landscapes designation as a UNESCO World Heritage Site as fact and fiction blend to reveal the romance of the Land of Evangeline. Visit a local winery for a tour and tasting before returning to Halifax for the evening. We are staying at the Cambridge Suites. (B)

August 20th, 2018 Halifax NS to Oak Island NS

Discover the rustic charm of the renowned fishing Village of Peggy's Cove where you will enjoy breakfast overlooking one of the most photographed lighthouses in the world. We travel the South Shore and on the UNESCO World Heritage Town of Lunenburg, renowned for her fleets of Grand Banks fishing schooners. Take a walking tour to fully experience one of the most remarkably preserved colonial settlements in the New World, and visit the Fisheries Museum of the Atlantic to learn about the town's famous seafaring heritage. After some free time in Mahone Bay, arrive in the legendary Oak Island areas Western Shore for the night and learn of the world's longest running hunt for lost treasure before checking into a peaceful and serene ocean-side resort; the Atlantica Hotel & Marina Oak Island (B, D)

August 21st, 2018 Oak Island NS to Charlottetown PE

Learn about the Mi'kmaq people at Millbrook Cultural & Heritage Centre before crossing Confederation Bridge, the world's longest continuous multi-span bridge, to Prince Edward Island. We check into the hotel Rodd Charlottetown for a two-night stay. Enjoy a theatre performance by local entertainers at the Confederation Centre of the Arts (a substitution may be necessary due to theatre schedule). (B)

August 22nd, 2018 Prince Edward Island Touring

This morning is a free morning in Charlottetown, Canada's birthplace, or join a complimentary walking tour of the city. This afternoon, tour the scenic North Shore of the island. Drive by red cliffs, white beaches, gently sloping sand dunes and green fields of Prince Edward Island National Park and visit Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place, the alluring inspiration of Lucy Maud Montgomery's classic books. Experience true maritime hospitality this evening at a traditional hall-style lobster Supper. (B, D)

August 23rd, 2018 Charlottetown PE to Baddeck NS

Ferry over to the Northumberland Strait back to Nova Scotia and proceed to Cape Breton Island, the Scotland of North America, via the Canso Causeway. Visit Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site in Baddeck to learn of the many accomplishments of this genius who made his home on the island before checking into our hotel Inverary on Baddeck Bay on the Bras d'Or Lake where we spend the next two nights. (B, D)

August 24th, 2018 Cabot Trail Touring

Experience one of the most stunningly picturesque drives in North America today as you tour the Cabot Trail which winds around the rocky splendor of Cape Breton's northern shore,

ascending to the incredible plateaus of Cape Breton Highlands National Park. Look-offs offer unforgettable vistas of Cape Breton's rugged coastline so be sure to have your camera on hand. Your day is completed by a Whale Watching Boat Tour (Weather permitting) (B, BL, D)

August 25th, 2018 Baddeck NS to Halifax NS

Fortress of Louisbourg National Historic Site awaits today and words cannot do justice to this reconstruction depicting one fifth of the settlement of 1744 New France. Roam the streets and chat with authentically costumed guides. Proceed along the shore of the Bras de la Mer lake to the mainland, and back to Halifax for one last night in the Maritimes. Cambridge Suites (B)

August 26th, 2018

This morning we depart for the airport to start making our way home. When we land back in Kelowna our coach will be waiting for us. We are then off for lunch in Kelowna and then home. (CB, L)
